The sole purpose of CFYDC (Chance) existence is to make a difference in young people's lives. It provides opportunities for young people to participate in a range of sports, self-development and educational activities. CFYDC caters for young people and adults regardless of background, race, religion, ethnicity or gender. The center is open to all regardless of ability or disability. It caters for children from all over the Leeds area but particularly those from the inner city areas of north and northeast Leeds.

Our most recent innovative project funded by the National Big Lottery Fund seeks to prevent Young people's involvement/interaction with gangs/Criminality in inner city Leeds with a focus on Chapeltown and surrounding areas. Gangs and gang/criminality involvement result in short- and long-term negative outcomes for gang-involved youth, their friends and families, and the surrounding communities.

- As part of a new team you will be responsible for the line-management of a number of outreach staff and to assure and develop the quality of their practice standards.
- You will also ensure that young people joining the program receive best interventions that are likely to reduce the likelihood of gang interaction /further involvement / offending which will include training, mentorship and family support to achieve positive outcome.
- The Project Manager will lead the on-going development and review of work in the areas of social rehabilitation, youth leadership training and youth mentoring.
- The right person for this role will have proven experience of working with Young People, Communities and Organisations to bring about cohesive action plans and develop new projects/ideas also.
- They will be able to build relationships with a variety of different stakeholders and be willing to spread the word about our work through delivering presentations and attending events.
- We are looking for someone who can work with staff and volunteers, truly appreciate their contribution and importance within the organisation, and support them to take ownership over their work.
- Ideally the person will have experience of designing and delivering training and also designing and sourcing resources to support delivery plan.
- For all roles you will need to combine your experience with values that match ours.

Innovation, honesty, integrity and a genuine desire to improve the lives of young people will be at the heart of everything you do.

This project has three years of funding until March 2021.
