The sole purpose of CFYDC (Chance) existence is to make a difference in young people's lives. It provides opportunities for young people to participate in a range of sports, self-development and educational activities. CFYDC caters for young people and adults regardless of background, race, religion, ethnicity or gender. The center is open to all regardless of ability or disability. It caters for children from all over the Leeds area but particularly those from the inner city areas of north and northeast Leeds.

Our most recent innovative project funded by the National Big Lottery Fund seeks to prevent Young people's involvement/interaction with gangs/Criminality/Mindset in inner city Leeds with a focus on Chapeltown and surrounding areas. Gangs and gang involvement result in short- and long-term negative outcomes for gang-involved youth, their friends and families, and the surrounding communities.

- As part of a new team you will provide direct support to young people who are or are at risk off being involved in gang related activity.
- You will work closely with young people, their families and a range of local services in the area to reduce risks and to support/prevent Gang involvement.
- Support Young people to be able to access our onsite-mentoring or accredited leadership training programs.
- You will be an experienced project worker with a relevant social care/youth work qualification.
- You will need to have in-depth knowledge of the issues surrounding troubled young people, an understanding of Child Protection and Safeguarding processes together with the tact and diplomacy to handle sensitive and confidential issues.
- For all roles you will need to combine your experience with values that match ours.

Innovation, honesty, commitment and a genuine desire to improve the lives of young people will be at the heart of everything you do.

This project has three years of funding until March 2021.
